Instructions

Part 1

Take a walk along your street with a grown up and look for any numbers (on houses or letterboxes).

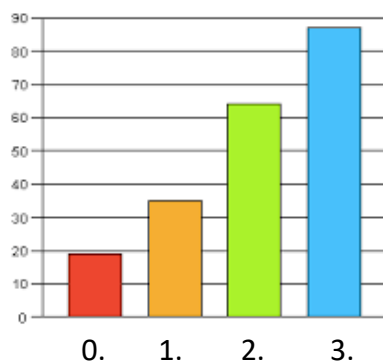


Either write the numbers on a piece of paper.
