

Salt Watercolour

Ingredients:

- Salt (table, cooking, rock or a combination)
- Paper
- Watercolour paint or water with a few drops of food colouring
- Brushes or cotton buds
- White crayon or PVA glue (optional)



Instructions:

- Use your brush or cotton bud to apply watercolours to the paper
- Sprinkle with salt and allow to dry before shaking any excess off
- Tips:
 - Use enough paint so there is moisture sitting on the page (not all soaked in)
 - Salt has to be added while the watercolour is still wet so paint a bit then add salt, then paint a bit more then add more salt

Ideas:

- Use white crayon or PVA glue to draw on the paper before painting
- Try different ways to add the paint – brushing, dripping, spraying, splashing
