

## Colour Scavenger Hunt

### Equipment:

- Card/paper with the name of a colour written or drawn on each
- Set of coloured objects (e.g. pencils)

### Instructions:

- Ask your student to find objects in the house that match each colour – they may be able to match from the written word - RED, a spoken instruction “find me something RED”, or matching to a coloured object like a RED pencil
- Continue until your student has found an object to match each colour you have requested

### Ideas:

- Ask for various shades e.g. light/dark brown
- An object with more than one colour on it e.g. yellow and green
- A colour made from 2 other colours e.g. red and blue makes... purple
- Play “I spy something that is (colour)”
