## Strip Art Shapes

Equipment:

- Cardboard or paper
- Magazine, catalogue, gift paper
- Scissors
- Glue


Instructions:

- On the cardboard or paper student (or you) draws a large shape - heart, square, triangle, animal (whatever your student likes) and cuts it out
- Student (or you) cuts long strips approximately $1-2 \mathrm{~cm}$ wide (depending on fine motor dexterity) from magazine/ catalogue/ gift wrap
- Student glues different strips side by side onto the paper shape
- Student (or you) trims overlapping strips from around the edge of the shape


## Ideas:

- Create a series of different shapes

- Create a pattern by using alternating colour strips or alternating width strips
