Raised Salt Drawings

Equipment:

- Baking tray or large dish
- Cardboard or paper plate
- Craft glue
- Table/cooking salt
- Watercolour paint or diluted food colouring
- Paint brush or dropper





Instructions:

- On the cardboard or paper plate, draw picture/ patterns/ squiggles with the craft glue
- Place the cardboard or paper plate on the tray/dish to catch any mess
- Sprinkle the salt over the glue until it is thoroughly covered and gently tip off any excess salt
- Use the brush or dropper to gently touch paint or food colour to the salt-covered glue lines and watch the colour spread along the line
- Let dry thoroughly (may take a day or two) before displaying

Ideas:

- Place different colours beside each other on the salt line and see if they blend to create a new colour
