

Watering indoor plants

Why is it important to water indoor plants?

It is important to water indoor plants because:

- They need water to live.
- It is part of good housekeeping.

These are the things you will need:

Indoor plants: there are many different types of indoor plants.



Pot and tray: the tray catches the extra water.



Spray bottle: filled with water.



How to water indoor plants:

1. Choose a spot for your indoor plant. Somewhere it can get a bit of light from a nearby window is good.



2. Don't move your plant around too much.



3. Put your finger into the soil in the pot to check if it is dry. If the soil is dry then your plant needs a drink.



4. Use a spray bottle with water to give your plant a drink. Spray the soil not the plant. Check your plant every Monday.



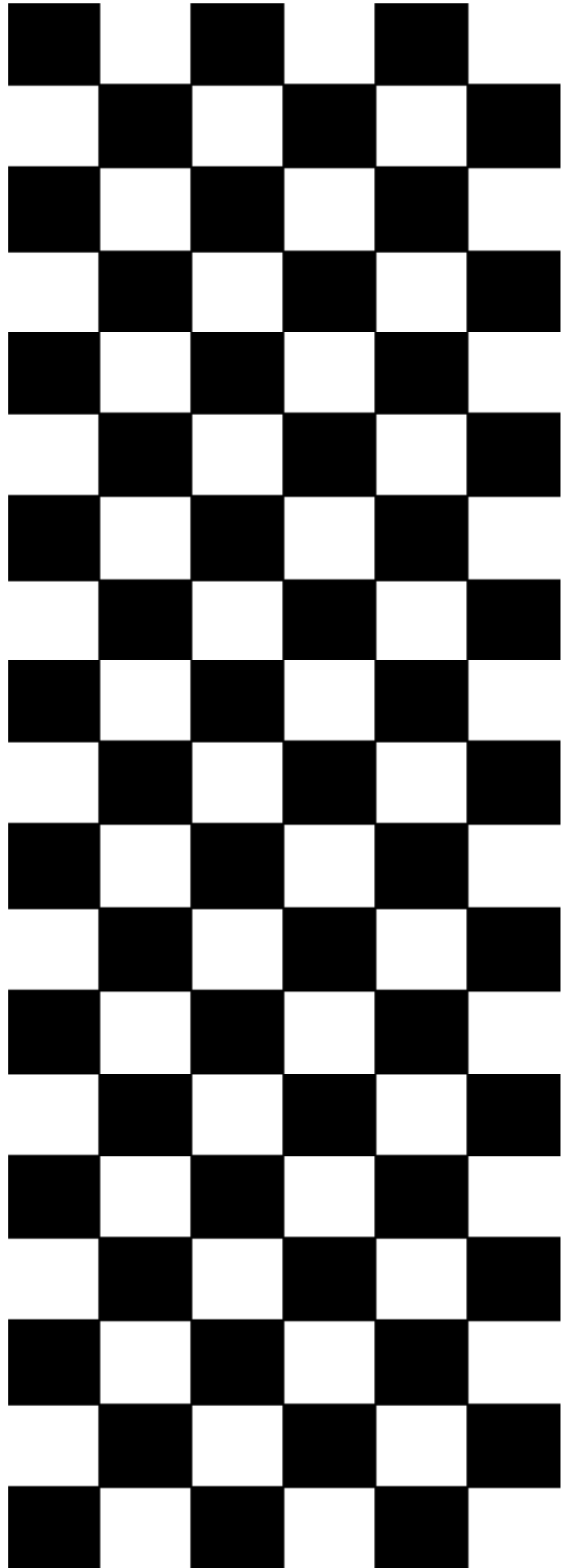
