

Geometric Art

Equipment:

- Paper
- Art materials - markers, coloured pencils, crayons, pastels, watercolour paints - whatever you have available!
- Ruler

Instructions:

- Use your ruler and a pen or marker to draw lines across the page from one side to the other – they can be vertical, horizontal and diagonal – make sure they cross over each other
- Use your art materials to colour the closed shapes or areas in different colours

Ideas:

- Discuss the shapes you can see – are there any squares, rectangles, triangles?
- Which area is the biggest/smallest, widest/skinniest?
- Look at artworks by Piet Mondrian (“Composition” series) – can you make an artwork that looks like these?
- Make another artwork, filling each shape or area with a different pattern – lines, dots, waves, zig zags
