
Separate the pictures into two categories, PUBLIC and PRIVATE.

Discuss with your child the difference between public and private places.

Public places are where other people may see us and include school, shops, playgrounds, and the beach. In these places we keep our clothes on and do not touch our private parts.

Private places are places where we can shut the door and be alone and include your bedroom, the bathroom and toileting areas. In these places we can remove our clothes and touch our private parts, but only when we are alone.

Practice using the words "public" and "private" with your child to increase their understanding of the concept.
