Id like to start by acknowledging the Awabakal People, the traditional custodians of the land on which Senior School learns. I acknowledge their continued connection to land, water and earth.

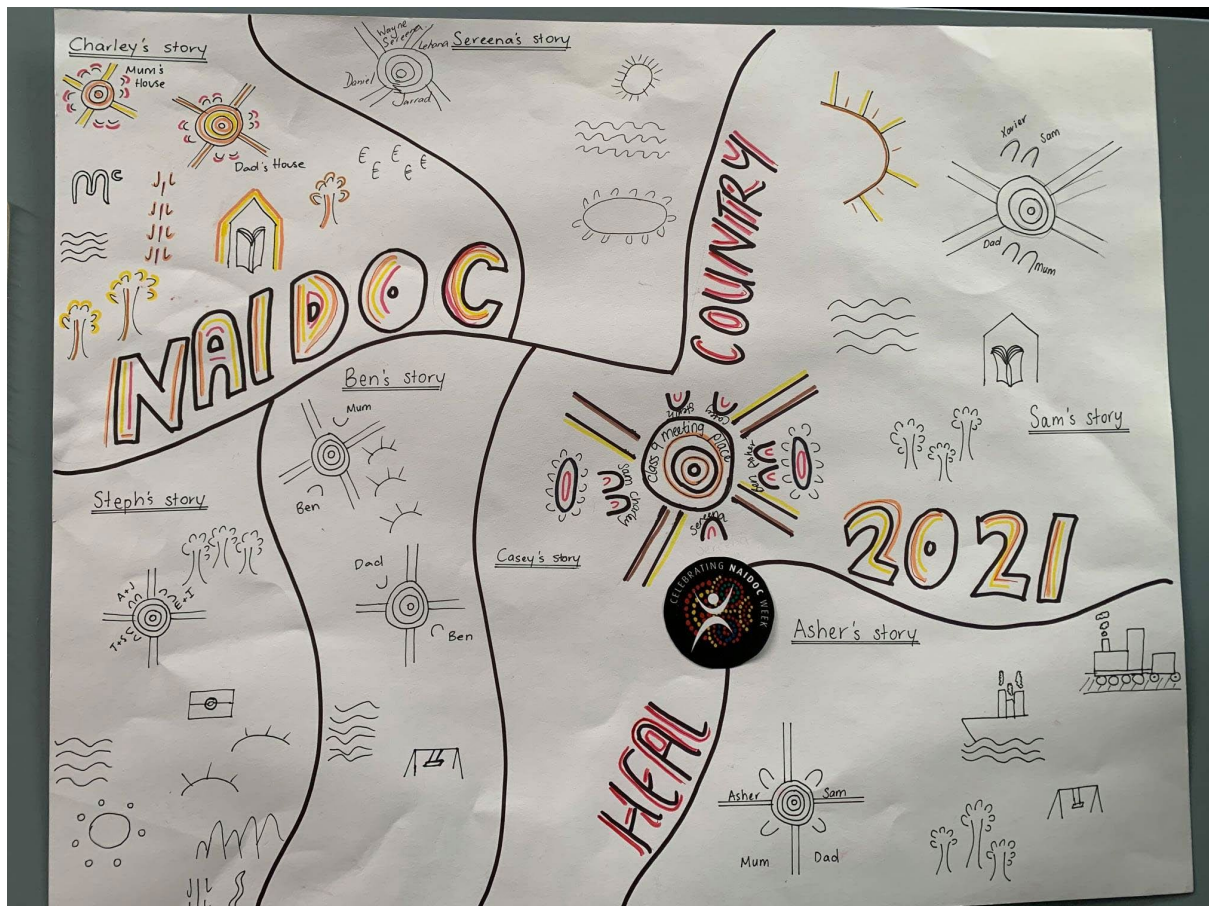
My Story

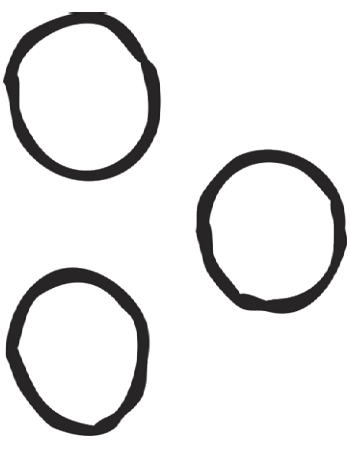
