

Pasta Art

Equipment:

- Uncooked pasta (any type)
- PVA glue
- Cardboard or paper plate
- Zip-lock bags, food colouring, vinegar and tray (optional)
- Markers or paint (optional)



Instructions:

- Colour your pasta using markers or paint if you would like to
- Use your pasta to create a collage or picture by gluing it onto the cardboard or paper plate – you might like to lay it in different directions or use different types of pasta if you have it
- You might prefer to dye your pasta the day before:
 - Add a tablespoon of vinegar and a splash of food colouring to a ziplock bag and mix together
 - Then add $\frac{3}{4}$ cup of dry pasta and seal the bag before gently shaking and turning the bag until the pasta is coloured
 - Spread on a tray to dry in the sun or a warm place (the vinegar smell will fade)

Ideas:

- Thread your pasta onto wool, string or ribbons
- Make a pattern using different colours or shapes of pasta
