

Paper Weaving

Equipment:

- Coloured paper or cardboard (wrapping paper, magazines or newspaper will work too)
- Scissors
- Pencil
- Ruler (or straight edge)



Instructions:

- Fold one piece of paper in half to make your “loom”
- Draw a line parallel to the open edges about 2cm down from the top
- From this line, draw lines down to the folded edge about every 2cm
- Then cut along these lines from the folded edge up to the first line you drew and unfold your paper “loom”
- Next, cut another piece of paper into 2 cm strips
- Thread one over and then under the strips in your “loom”, starting at the bottom. Thread the next one under then over, next to your first one.
- Continue until your loom is full, alternating whether you start with over or under
- Trim any overlapping edges
