Mathematics. Measuring.
Using measuring cup and spoons to measure ingredients to make Playdoh.


Measure 3 cups of flour (plain or selfraising) and tip them into a bowl.
Measure 1 cup of salt and tip it into the bowl with the flour and mix together.
Measure 1 cup of water and tip it into a jug.
Measure 4 tablespoons of oil (any variety) and tip it into the water.
Measure $\mathbf{1 / 2}$ tablespoon of food colouring (any colour) and tip it into the jug and mix together.
Add the liquid to the flour and salt and stir until the mixture is roughly combined. Use your hands to knead the playdoh until it is combined and ready to use.

NOTE. You can use half the amounts and make two different colours.
If the playdoh is dry add water. If it is too wet add more flour.
