

Chihuly Sculptures

Equipment:

- Empty plastic water bottles (the softer ones are easiest to use)
- Coloured permanent markers or paint
- Scissors

Instructions:

- Google Dale Chihuly and look at some of his colourful glass sculptures
- Colour around the outside of the bottle with permanent markers
- Carefully cut around the bottle so it forms a spiral (like peeling an apple in one piece)
- If you have paint, you can water it down and put some in your bottle. Put the lid on and shake and roll the bottle to coat it with paint. Remove the lid and leave paint to dry before cutting

Ideas:

- Hang your sculpture near a window so the sun shines through it
- Make more bottles and use them to create a hanging mobile
