

Abstract Art Designs

Equipment:

- Paper
- Art materials - markers, coloured pencils, crayons, pastels, watercolour paints - whatever you have available!

Instructions:

- Draw a continuous big loopy line with lots of curves. Have the line cross to make different size shapes.
- The more shapes your line or doodle makes, the more colourful your picture will be. There is no right or wrong way.
- Colour in the “shapes” your line created. If you want, you can leave some of the shapes white.

Ideas:

- Are there any shapes you can see? Which area is the biggest/smallest?
- Look at artworks by Joan Miro – can you make an artwork that looks like these?
- Make another artwork, filling each shape or area with a different pattern – lines, dots, waves, zig zags
