

Textile Wrapping



Ingredients:

- Sticks
- Wool, string, ribbon or narrow strips of fabric (cut up clean rags, old enviro bags)
- Scissors



Instructions:

- Google yarn bombing images. Check these out: <https://www.lovecrafts.com/en-us/c/article/yarn-bombing-around-the-world>
- Tie one end of the wool or fabric onto the end of your stick with a tight knot and wrap it back down the length of the stick
- When it is entirely covered in wool or fabric, tie it off and trim away the excess
- If you are using fabric, you may need to use a drop of PVA glue to secure the start and end in place

Ideas:

- make a cross or star shape decoration (or even a mobile) by tying 2 or more sticks together
- find other objects you could wrap – utensils, toys, toilet rolls, a tree in your yard
